First on the agenda, Richard Hope advised the Board that he received a letter from the Department of Environmental Protection and that monthly, quarterly and yearly reports must be filed.

Second on the agenda, Richard Hope suggested that the Board join the Solid Waste Association Of North America as they would prepare presentations and be a great source of information with respect to recycling.

Third on the agenda, Richard Hope advised the Board that an article would have to be put on for Special Town Meeting to pay the Blackstone and that \$899.50 should be asked for.


MOTION was made by Richard Hope, and seconded by David Caron and it was unanimously VOTED to adjourn the meeting at 7:30 p.m.

After the meeting was adjourned, Richard Hope appeared before the Advisory Board with respect to monies being set aside for capping of the landfill. The Advisory Board suggested that an Enterprise Fund be established and that the Board reserve receipts for appropriation if, in fact, receipts and/or tippings came in for landfill and that the monies could then be appropriated out at a Town Meeting and money could be ear marked with no fees charged against it.
