The meeting was held at the Town Hall on Thursday, June 16, 1994 at 7:00 p.m.

First on the Agenda, all mail was reviewed and any bills submitted to the Board at that time for payment were paid.

Second on the Agenda, open discussion concerning Northern Pike Trading Post occurred. Richard Hope advised the Board that he had been contacted by the Department of Environmental Protection and it was suggested that a letter be prepared to Northern Pike Trading Post advising them that the variance be recorded with the Registry of Deeds, that there cannot be more than eight (8) seats in the restaurant, that the restaurant must be "take out" only, that the system be pumped every six months, and that confirmation that the alarm is in working condition be supplied to the Board. Richard Hope made a Motion to have the Clerk prepare said letter, the motion was seconded by Ronald Nicoll and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED to have the Clerk prepare the letter for mailing to Northern Pike Trading Post, certified mail, return receipt requested.

Third on the Agenda, Richard Hope advised the Board that he received word from the Department of Public Health that there were high levels of mercury in the large mouth bass in Quaboag Pond. As such, at this time, it is not advisable to eat the large mouth bass more than twice a month. He then made a Motion to have a Notice posted at the boat ramp and on the Public Access Channel, as well as place an ad in the Telegram and Gazette and Wickaboag advising the community of same. Ronald Nicoll seconded the motion and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED to take appropriate steps to advise the community of same.

Fourth on the Agenda, Richard Hope advised the Board that Charlton Wells was putting in bed rock wells next week at the landfill and that the gas venting would be completed by Friday, June 3, 1994.

Fifth on the Agenda, Richard Hope advised that Ed Jeuder's services would be needed an extra day for clean up at the landfill. Accordingly, Richard Hope made a Motion, which was seconded by Ronald Nicoll, and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED to retain Ed Jeuder's services for an extra day.

Sixth on the Agenda, Richard Hope advised the Board that volunteers were needed at the dump every weekend to pass out dump stickers.

Seventh on the Agenda, meeting dates of July 7 and 21, 1994 were established. Richard Hope then made a Motion, which was seconded by Ronald Nicoll, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
