The meeting was held at the Town Hall on Thursday, July 7, 1994 at 7:00 p.m.

First on the Agenda, Ronald Allard appeared before the Board for purposes of introducing himself and to apply for the Plumbing Inspector position. After discussion, David Caron requested that a Vote be taken for purposes of appointing Mr. Allard to the position, the motion was seconded by Ronald Nicoll and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED that Ronald Allard would be appointed as the new Plumbing Inspector effective July 7, 1994.

Second on the agenda, David Caron advised the Board of a complaint he received from Bridget Atwood concerning Walter Walton's home and some faulty electrical outlets and holes in the wall board. David Caron contacted Mr. Atwood (876-8024) by telephone on July 6, 1994, but has not received a return phone call. David Caron advised the Board that he would provide an update on the matter at the next Board meeting.

Third on the agenda, David Caron advised the Board that he received a telephone call from Sid and Mindy Richardson (867-5308) on June 23, 1994, concerning property owned by Linda Smith and that the septic system was allegedly leeching out. David Caron contacted Ms. Smith and was advised that the system was pumped on June 14, 1994. David Caron also made an inspection of the property and it did not appear that the system was leeching on the ground. David Caron made a Motion, which was Seconded by Ronald Nicoll and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED that no further action would be taken at this time.

Fourth on the agenda, David Caron advised the Board that he received a complaint from Mr. and Mrs. Tim Gevivalent of Central Street concerning alleged lead paint in the building in which they reside, but which is owned by Dr. Mauvroides. The Gevivalts also alleged that there is asbestos in the cellar and that the State was called in April to inspect the property. The property was, in fact, inspected by Loretta Risk. David Caron made a Motion that no further action be taken until the Board received a copy of the report from the State, the motion was Seconded by Ronald Nicoll and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED that no further action would be taken at this time.

Fifth on the agenda, in that all business affairs were attended David Caron made a Motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was Seconded by Ronald Nicoll and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED to adjourn at 7:55 p.m.
