The meeting was held at the Town Hall on Saturday, July 22, 1995 at 10:00 a.m.

First on the Agenda, David Caron advised the Board that Board had received a letter from Attorney Neill Schoomaker concerning Harvey Bennett and Ms. Marion Thomas' suit against him. Within the letter, Attorney Schoomaker inquired as to whether or not the Board of Health voted or communicated to Ms. Thomas that she was not to enter the landfill. David Caron indicated that he had no recollection of any such conversation or vote taking place, but that he would check into the matter further with Harvey Bennett and then with the Board of Selectmen.

Second on the Agenda, David Caron indicated that the Board had received the "Plan for the Landfill" from Cox Engineer and after a brief discussion concerning same made a Motion, which was SECONDED by Robert Wentzell, and the Board UNANIMOUSLY VOTED in favor of the proposal, signed same, and requested that the Clerk forward same to Cox Engineering.

Third on the Agenda, Robert Wentzell indicated to the Board that Donald Maplebeck still had not paid for the construction and demolition materials he brought in to the landfill and requested that the Secretary follow-up on the matter by sending an invoice for \$360.00, with a note to remit payment in full within 30 days.

Fourth on the Agenda, Robert Wentzell indicated that the 30 yard roll off (from the Grant) would be delivered on Monday and that the landfill would now accept mixed paper at the landfill.

Fifth on the Agenda, all matters having been addressed David Caron made a Motion, which was SECONDED by Robert Wentzell and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED to adjourn the meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 11:15 a.m.

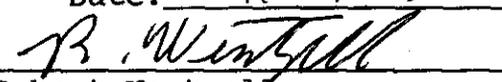
