

Brookfield Board of Health
March 4, 2008
Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 5:15 PM with all members present.

Transfer Station- Jim Hanson has requested a first aid kit and a fire extinguisher for the transfer station. The board agreed to purchase them. Kim Longe will look into the possibility of having a phone installed at the Transfer Station.
Salvation Army- has still not emptied the boxes.

Housing- 3 Hyde St. Francis Mann sent an e-mail informing the board that the tenant in Apartment 1 will be moving out. He expects to have the lead encapsulation completed by March 31, 2008

Permit Fees- Kim Longe presented a list of the proposed fees. The Public Hearing for the fee increase is scheduled for 6:00 PM at the Town Hall.

Lakeside Campground-The Board of Health met with other town officials in executive session on February 25, 2008 at 6:00 PM to discuss Lakeside Camping Area. Tim McElroy made a motion to advise the Board of Selectmen that the Board of Health is in agreement with the town's proposed procedure to foreclose on Lakeside Campground. Kim Longe seconded the motion; so voted.

6:00 PM – the Board of Health adjourned their meeting to conduct the Public Hearing on the proposed fee schedule.

6:40 PM- the Board of Health meeting was reconvened.

Emergency Preparedness- Sara D'Alessio, Region II consultant explained the Mutual Aid Agreement for Board's of Health that is being circulated among all the towns in Worcester County. She gave a brief overview of ICS and NIMS compliance.

South Pond Beach-the town will be responsible for having the water tested at the beach for the swimming season. Kim Longe volunteered to handle the beach.

Board of Health Future- Mike Seery stated, "I am prepared to step into the chairman's seat."

Open Discussion- Mike Seery witnessed the disposal of six cases of recalled beef.

Mike Seery made a motion to accept the minutes of February 19, 2008 Tim McElroy seconded; so voted.

The next meeting will be held March 17, 2008 at 5:30 PM

The meeting adjourned at 7:20PM on a motion from Kim Longe and a second from Tim McElroy; so voted.
