

Brookfield Board of Health
Minutes
Tuesday, July 12, 2011

In attendance: Mike Seery, Dan Leahy, Ron Wassmer and Lucinda Thompson,

Meeting called to order at 5:38 PM

Minutes of 5/10/11, 6/10/11, 6/23/11 were accepted on a motion by Mike Seery with a second from Ron Wassmer; so voted.

Ratification of Warrants- Expense warrants and payroll warrant for the Board of Health and Transfer Station for 6/30/11 and 7/7/11, 7/14/11 were all ratified on a motion from Mike Seery with a second from Dan Leahy; so voted.

Review of Title 5 Plans and Inspection Reports- the board reviewed the septic plans and Title 5 inspection reports.

Plans for Nicholas & Christine Swope- Mike made a motion to grant approval of the plan subject to the town granting a 10'x10' right of way for the well or possibly relocating the well.

Discussion with Ed Williams, Sr.-Ed Williams informed the board that he recently has been detecting a strong odor of burning trash. He also stated that he had contacted the assistant fire chief with his concerns. They suspect that the odor is coming from the Outdoor Wood Boiler located at 64 South Maple St. Cindy Thompson also mentioned a problem with wood smoke coming in to the house at 29 Fiskdale Rd. Mike Seery informed the board that he had received a complaint from Mark Farrell, 31 Fiskdale Rd. The source of this smoke is believed to be 5 Long Hill Rd. Mike Seery made motion to send a letters to Jim Dolan & David Terry telling them that the board has received a complaints about odor from their wood boilers and advising them that they are not in compliance and the situation must be addressed. DEP regulations will be included. Dan Leahy seconded the motion; so voted.

Discussion of Transfer Station: the work at the Transfer Station should be starting soon. The blocks have been delivered for building a ramp to the metal dumpster. Stickers for 2012 are available at the Transfer Station now. Mike Seery made a motion to charge \$85.00 for a first sticker and \$5.00 for a second sticker. Stickers will only be available for purchase at the Transfer Station. Dan Leahy seconded the motion; so voted. Transfer Station regulations will be reviewed and ratified at the next meeting.

Discussion of **Flu Clinics:** Mike Seery informed the board that C V S will be conducting this year's flu clinic. Public Health nurse Cheryl Rawinski will attend to take blood pressure.

The next meeting was tentatively scheduled for August 8, 2011 at 5:30 PM at the Highway Garage.

Ron Wassmer made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 PM, Dan Leahy, seconded;

so voted.
