Meeting called to order at 5:38 PM

Minutes of 4/10/12 were accepted on a motion by Mike Seery with a second from Dan Leahy; so voted.

Discussion of brook on Kimball St.- Mike will check with Bruce Clarke regarding when he is taking water samples to Microbac and take a batch sample from the brook at the same time.

Review of Title 5 Plans and Inspection Reports- the board reviewed the following plans: 12 High St.- the board acknowledges the separate gray water
179 Rice Corner Rd.- verbal OK for the well was given
61 Quaboag St- approved
5 Howard St- Application for a Local Upgrade Approval was approved
The above plans were approved on a motion from Mike Seery with a second from dan Leahy.

Discussion regarding the hiring of Jim Milner- the board agreed not to hire Mr. Milner at this time and being unable to reach a consensus they agreed to table the discussion until the following meeting.

Discussion of Transfer Station: electrical work and cameras. Mike made a motion to install three motion activated cameras, Dan seconded the motion. Two other quotes for the electrical work & the cameras must be obtained before the work can proceed.



Discussion of Transfer Station Stickers- Mike made a motion to purchase light blue stickers from Walnut Printing, dan seconded the motion.

Discussion of Food Permits: Mike made a motion not to charge "Town of Brookfield" municipal departments (Fire Department, Cultural Council, Apple Country Fair, Schools and the Recreation Committee) for their food permits. The BOH will absorb the cost of paying the inspector from their budget.

Mike Seery made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:30 PM, Dan Leahy, seconded; so voted.
