



July 9, 1956


Board met at 7:30 P.M. with only 2 members present, Gussie L. Willett and Henry Lournier. Bills read and approved.


Board met at 7:30 P.M. with all present. Bills were read and approved.







done about getting flood aid for dam at her pond.


Discussion on Barbara Palamountain Dancing School.
