Brookfield Elementary School Building Committee.


For the records in regards to Mr. Mauhin receiving

offered \$300.00


Boro Wrecking Co., So. Bellingham, Mass.

Discussed the \$7820.61 718 Bond Issue, made available by the General Court for the Highway Dept.


The Board discussed this with the Highway Supt. All hands agreed to make a survey on Sunday, Nov. 2 of our Highways to decide where to spend this money.

Nov. 6, 1956


Board met at 7:30 P.M. with all members present.


Board met at 7:30 P.M. with all members present.




Board met at 7:30 P.M. with all members present.

## MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S SPECIAL MEETING


Dec. 6, 1956
