MINUTES FOR December 10, 2002

MR. GRAUPNER, MR. HAYES, MR. GRIFFIN VS. TOWN OF BROOKFIELD

The Executive Session opened at 10: 56 p.m. Beverly A. Lund, Robert S. Phillips, and Joseph J. Klimavich were present.

Mr. Phillips advised that he had contacted Michele Randazzo, Town Counsel, and told her that Mr. Griffin had not contacted the Board and that he had not return to work by the requested date of Monday, December 9, 2002. Ms. Randazzo advised Mr. Phillips that in her opinion Mr. Griffin has waived his right to return to work in Brookfield unless the union lawyer failed to communicate the Board's instructions to him.

Mr. Phillips moved to instruct Town Counsel to notify Mr. Griffin that he has waived his right to come to work in Brookfield and the back wages will be paid as soon as the amounts are agreed upon; Mr. Klimavich seconded. Mr. Phillips voted aye; Mr. Klimavich voted aye; Ms. Lund voted aye.

The Board agreed that the counter offers proposed to Mr. Graupner and Mr. Hayes would remain in place until December 16, 2002.

Ms. Lund entertained a motion to instruct Town Counsel to advise that if Mr. Hayes and Mr. Griffin should decline the Board's latest offer then she should advise them to return to work Monday, December 30, 2002. Mr. Klimavich moved; Mr. Phillips seconded. Mr. Phillips voted aye; Mr. Klimavich voted aye; Ms. Lund voted aye; so voted.

ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Phillips moved to adjourn the Executive Session meeting at 11:06pm; Mr. Klimavich seconded. Mr. Phillips voted aye; Mr. Klimavich voted aye; Ms. Lund voted aye.
