Ms. Lund advised that MIIA will not cover any back wages regarding the Labor Relations Commission suits. They will consider covering wages that fall under a MCAD claim.

The Board is anxious to resolve the back wages issue and is waiting for the plaintiff's lawyer's reply by January 27, 2003 and this can be accomplished whether or not W2s are received by January 27, 2003..

Mr. Phillips suggested that there is no reason to pursue the lawsuit against Mr. Graupner because he understands that Mr. Graupner returned all the Police Department items as requested.

Mr. Phillips moved to drop the lawsuit against Mr. Graupner pending receipt of a confirmation letter from Chief Ackerman that all the Police Department items that were requested from Mr. Graupner have been returned; Mr. Klimavich seconded. Mr. Phillips voted aye; Mr. Klimavich voted aye; Ms. Lund voted aye.
