MINUTES OF MARCH 3, 2009
EXECUTIVE SESSION

Attendees: Selectman Ronald J. Dackson, Selectman James Allen and Selectman Rudy Heller

Mr. Allen called the meeting to order at 6:25 p.m. The meeting was posted for 6 p.m. but Mr. Allen was delayed by an unforeseen event.

Mr. Dackson moved to go into Executive Session stating Exception to the Open Meeting Law Number 3, "*...to discuss strategy relating to collective bargaining ... if an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining ... position of the governmental body, to conduct strategy session in preparation ... to conduct collective bargaining sessions or contract negotiations....*" with no intention of reconvening in Open Session once the Executive Session was adjourned. Mr. Allen seconded.

The purpose of the meeting was to continue reviewing the proposal submitted by the NEPBA to the Town of Brookfield.

The Board discussed Articles 1, 2, 3 4,5, and 6, and made additions, deletions and changes to the proposal submitted by the NEPBA.

The Board agreed postpone the vote on whether or not to include the Chief into the negotiating team, and to continue reading the contract individually, as well as to meet again to discuss items article by article and section by section.

Mr. Dackson moved to reconvene on Friday, March 6 at 10 a.m. in Open Session with the intention of going into Executive Session to continue the process. Mr. Heller seconded. Roll call vote taken as follows
