MINUTES OF August 11, 2009

Executive Session

Mr. Heller convened the executive session at 9:30 P.M. Also present: Mr. Allen and Mr. O'Connell

The purpose of the executive session was to discuss the progress of negotiations with union personnel. Mr. O'Connell reported that in its most recent proposal to the Town, the Police Union had not made any movement toward compromise. Therefore, on advice of Town Counsel Brian Maser, Mr. O'Connell recommended that the Town advise the Union that they should seek mediation. Mr. O'Connell reported that mediation could take several months, given the recent cutback in the number of mediators as a result of state budget cuts.

Mr. O'Connell moved that the Town inform the Union that it should seek mediation. Mr. Allen seconded. Mr. Allen voted AYE, Mr. Heller voted AYE and Mr. O'Connell voted AYE.

At 10:10 Mr. Allen moved to go out of executive session and return to open session for the purpose of adjournment and Mr. O'Connell seconded the motion. Mr. Allen voted AYE, Mr. Heller voted AYE and Mr. O'Connell voted AYE.
