**EXECUTIVE SESSION #1 of 3**

At about 9:25 pm, Mr. Heller called the first Executive Session to order giving reason #6 below:

**Exception Six** - "To consider the purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property, if such discussions may have a detrimental effect on the negotiating position of the governmental body and a person, firm or corporation."

**Possible Purchase of Property on Prouty Street:**

Mr. O'Connell asked the Board to consider writing a letter to the heirs of Mr. Robert McKeon who now owned four lots on Prouty and Central Street. Two of the four lots abut the Town Hall property and are needed for emergency vehicle exit to Prouty Street. Mr. Allen said that the Town had approached Mr. McKeon two times that he knew of and the second time there was no response.

Mr. Allen suggested sending the heirs' Trust a letter, extending sympathy upon the recent loss of their father and expressing interest in the Prouty Street property if they should ever be interested in selling and/or asking for an option-to-buy. The Board agreed to do this and Ms. Neylon will draft the letter.
