MINUTES OF July 27, 2010

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At about 9:40 pm, Mr. Heller called the first Executive Session to order giving reason #3 below:

Exception Three - "To discuss strategy relating to collective bargaining or to litigation if an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining or litigating position of the governmental body, to conduct strategy sessions in preparation for negotiations with nonunion personnel, to conduct collective bargaining sessions or contract negotiations with nonunion personnel."

Town Hall Roof:

Mr. Allen reported receiving a contract from Town Counsel, Thomas McEnaney, for the engineering firm: (SG&H). The Board had many questions and Mr. Allen will research these questions and report at the next meeting. The engineering firm is expected to come to the Town Hall in mid-August after the brick mason has returned and will use his lift to get closer to the roof. It is understood that they will take some samples for research. The Board must also decide if they want to use some slate already in the Town's possession which may or may not be the exact color of if other, matching slate will be purchased.
