

**BOARD OF SELECTMEN

JANUARY 11, 2011

EXECUTIVE SESSION # 3 OF 4

At about 3:45 pm, Mr. Heller called to order Executive Session #3 of 4, citing (and reading aloud) Exemption three:

Exception Three - "To discuss strategy relating to collective bargaining or to litigation if an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining or litigating position of the governmental body, to conduct strategy sessions in preparation for negotiations with nonunion personnel, to conduct collective bargaining sessions or contract negotiations with nonunion personnel."

Complaint from Mr. Wharton regarding Town's maintenance of Chestnut Street (aka Pine Street):

Mr. Heller reported that he had talked with the Town Clerk, Treasurer and Town Account and they have no record of any bond issued to the Town by these people as negotiated in the court decision between Mr. Wharton and neighbors on Chestnut Street. The Accountant said that this goes back 21 years and her computer records do not go back that far. Mr. Heller will follow up with a call to at least one of the abutters.

Mr. Allen will call the Highway Superintendent to make sure the right of way is appropriately marked, that the Highway conducts no maintenance to Chestnut Street and, with the big snow storm due tomorrow, that the Highway only plows Chestnut Street with a small truck.

At approximately 3:49 pm, Mr. Heller entertained a motion to adjourn the Executive Session and move to Open Session for the purpose of adjournment; Mr. Allen so moved; Mr. O'Connell seconded; so voted with Mr. Allen voting Aye and Mr. O'Connell voting Aye.
