**EXECUTIVE SESSION # 4 OF 4**

At about 3:49 pm, Mr. Heller called the fourth Executive Session to order under Exemption two of the Open Meeting Law:

**Exception Two** - "to discuss strategy in preparation for negotiations with non-union personnel or to conduct collective bargaining session or contract negotiations with non-union personnel"

Retirement of Ross B. Ackerman:

Although the official letter announcing the granting of Mr. Ackerman's retirement as filed by the Board of Selectmen, has not yet been received, it was granted at the Retirement Board's December meeting. The retirement application filed by Mr. Ackerman is still under consideration by the Worcester Regional Retirement Board and is expected to be on their February or March agenda.

The Board previously authorized Mr. O'Connell and Treasurer Jim Dunbar to send a letter to Mr. Ackerman as soon as the Town receives official notification of the Retirement Board's decision. The letter will inform Mr. Ackerman that if he wishes to continue his health insurance, he must make arrangements to pay the unpaid balance of his health insurance premiums for the period June through January in the amount of approximately \$3,289.

At about 3:55 pm; Mr. O'Connell moved to adjourn the Executive Session and return to open session for the purpose of adjourning; Mr. Allen seconded; so voted with Mr. Allen voting aye; Mr. O'Connell voting aye; and Mr. Heller voting aye.
