EXECUTIVE SESSION # 2 OF 2

At about 10:05 pm, Mr. Heller called the second Executive Session to order under Exemption six of the Open Meeting Law:

Exception Three - "To discuss strategy relating to collective bargaining or to litigation if an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining or litigating position of the governmental body, to conduct strategy sessions in preparation for negotiations with nonunion personnel, to conduct collective bargaining sessions or contract negotiations with nonunion personnel."

Mark Hammond, Rice Corner Road, owner/operator of a "Repossession Lot"

On February 25, 2011, the Board received a copy of a letter from Town Counsel sent to Mr. Mark Hammond asking him to cease and desist (by March 25, 2011) from operation of his repossession lot on Rice Corner Road as he is in violation of the Zoning By-law. Mr. O'Connell noted that the Zoning Enforcement Officer should begin fining Mr. Hammond immediately after March 25th if he has not complied.

At approximately 10:150 pm, Mr. Allen moved at adjourn the Executive Session and to return to Open Session for the purpose of adjournment; Mr. O'Connell seconded; so voted with Mr. Allen voting Aye; Mr. O'Connell voting Aye; and Mr. Heller voting Aye.
