There was discussion of some points to include or not include in the contract.

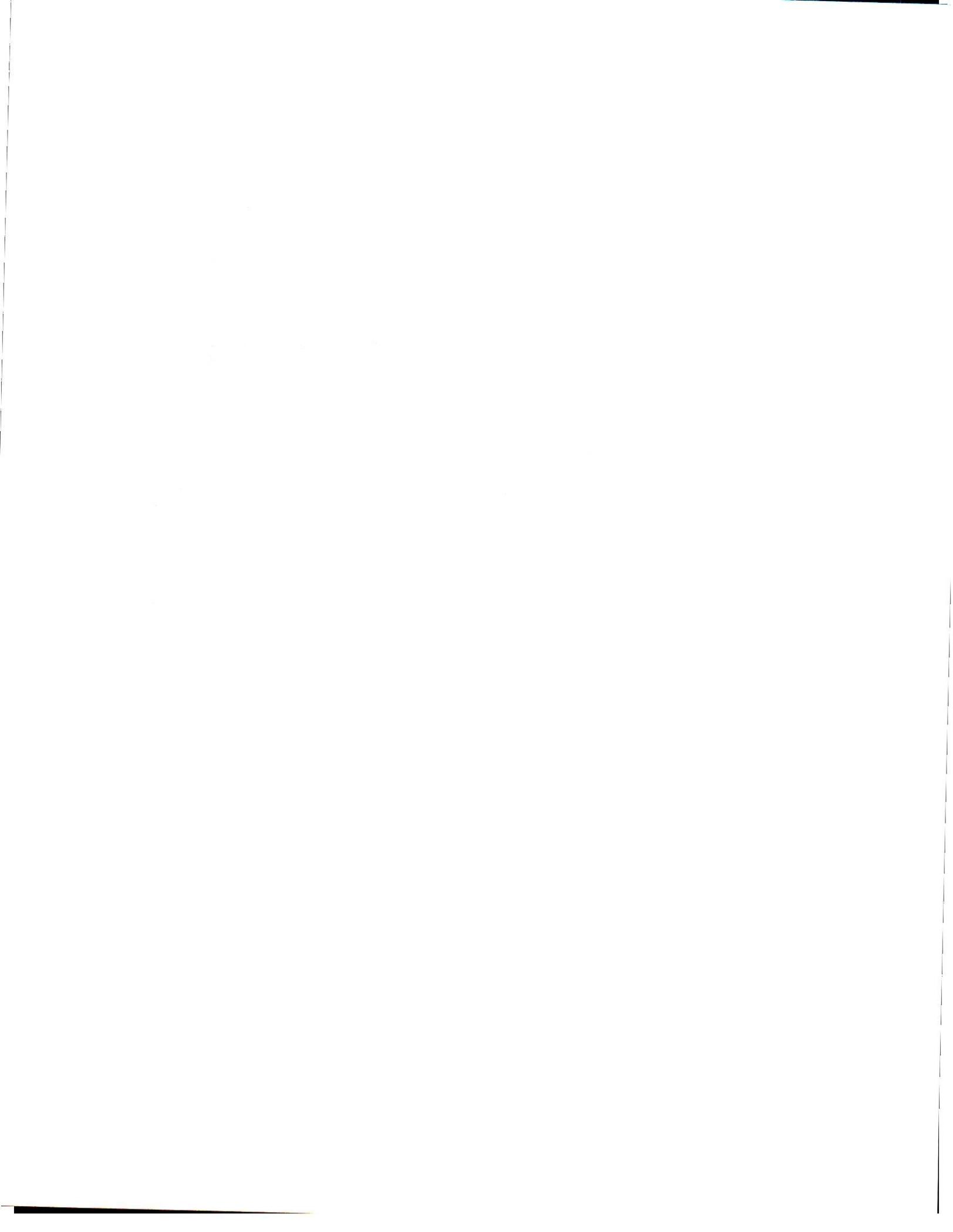
