Mr. O'Connell called the Executive Session to order at 8:34 pm under Exemption three (below):

**Exemption 3. To discuss strategy with respect to collective bargaining or litigation if an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining or litigating position of the public body and the chair so declares;**

**Mr. Hoffey's sign:**

Mr. O'Connell explained that he had been advised by Town Counsel that the court had denied Mr. Hoffey's injunction against the Town and the Commonwealth. It is the intent to line up the Town's (and Zoning Officer) position with that of the Commonwealth's permit that they have issued with the stated terms and conditions. The Town will not make Mr. Hoffey go through the Zoning Board of Appeals if he abides by the State's rules. The Board agreed that some assurances are needed by the Town as to possible liability from the placement of Mr. Hoffey's sign.

At 8:45 pm, Mr. Comtois moved to adjourn the Executive Session and return to Open Session; Mr. Heller seconded; so voted with Mr. Comtois voting aye; Mr. Heller voting aye; and Mr. O'Connell voting aye.
