


By-Law Committee Meeting

The meeting opened at approximately 6:15 p.m. Mr. Rudy Heller taped the meeting for the local cable access channel. James Cooke and Rudy Heller took the oath of office from Town Clerk and committee member Michael P. Seery.

- Copies of revised by-laws were distributed to the members.
- The charge was then reviewed by the members. Mr. Cooke suggested that the committee should determine which by-laws did not work or needed amendments while determining which by-laws were legal.
- Mr. Heller emphasized that the first duty of the Committee was to ensure that we have a By-Law book in which everything has been reviewed.
- The committee also discussed whether it made sense or not to invite Assistant Attorney General Margaret Hurley and Kelli Gunagan to a future meeting to discuss the by-law charge or get an opinion from them regarding the approach committee is using to follow the charge. Mr. Cooke felt that attorney general's office would not be able to offer advisory opinions. Mr. Heller felt that any advice we could get from somebody who has done a by-law book reconciliation and updating would be helpful to complete our charge.
- The committee then agreed to start reviewing the by-laws and matching the attorney generals approvals.
- Mr. Seery agreed that he would have copies of the 1948, 1966, 1979, and 1985 By-Law books ready for all the committee members at their next meeting.
- The committee agreed to meet again on Wednesday February 23rd 2011 at 6 p.m. and during that meeting schedule at least 4 meetings in advance.
- The meeting adjourned at 7:50 P.M.
