**Meeting Opened at 6:19 p.m.**

- The committee could not find attorney general's approval for Chapter 10 Section 16 revision (driveway by-law) as adopted by the November 2008 Town Meeting.
- The committee searched for when the open container by-law was rescinded.
- Cindy Mundell made a motion to put the fine details in the appropriate section of the by-law. James Cooke Seconded and all were in favor.
- Because the town repealed Chapter 5 section 5 at the May 2002 Town Meeting the committee believes that the remaining sections should be renumbered hence, Cindy Mundell made a motion that the current Section 6 now becomes Section 5- Section 7 (Mileage reimbursement) becomes Section 6 and Section 8 becomes Section 7. Barbara Wilson seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.
- Because the By-Law committee could not find the Attorney General's approval for the November 2008 town meeting vote changing Section 16 (see attached document for town meeting vote) Cindy made a motion to keep the current section 16 as written. Mike Seery Seconded and all are in favor. Unanimous vote.
- Barbara Wilson moved to create a new chapter 18 called Dogs. Chapter 12 Section 1 (add 1.0 through 1.7) will become Chapter 18, Section 1 and Chapter 10 Section 17 will now become Chapter 18 Section 2, and Section 5 Fines for Leash laws now becomes Chapter 18 Section 3. Mike Seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Unanimous.
- Cindy Mundell made a motion to delete chapter 12 section 1.8 (effective date) as unnecessary. Barbara Wilson seconded and all were in favor. Unanimous.

- Cindy Mundell moved to renumber chapter 12 sections 2 through 6 will now be 1 through 5. Mike Seery seconded and all were in favor. Unanimous.
- Cindy Mundell moved to renumber Chapter 15 (Personnel By-Law) See Town Clerk for copy. Chapter 16 (Water Use Restriction) and Chapter 17 (Non-Zoning Wetland By-Law). Barbara Wilson Seconded and all were in favor. Unanimous.
- Cindy Mundell made a motion to take section 29 (separability provision) and create Chapter 19 Section 1. (Separability provision). Barbara Wilson seconded and all voted in favor. Unanimous.
- Barbara moved and Cindy Mundell seconded to hold the next meeting on Wednesday May 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:15 p.m. All were in favor. Unanimous.
- Barbara Wilson moved and James Cooke seconded that Mike Seery and Cindy Mundell clean up master copy of the By-Laws. All were in favor. Unanimous.
- Cindy moved and Mike seconded to adjourn at 8:10 p.m.
