The meeting was opened at 7:00 p.m.

The “Pledge of Allegiance” was recited.

All members signed payroll vouchers for Beth Conant, Clerk.

At 7:10 p.m. Mr. Cleveland informed members about the bridge work on Quaboag Street regarding the flood plain issue.

At 7:17 p.m. Mr. Foster introduced himself as one of the Trustees of Quayside Shore Condominiums.

At 7:18 p.m. Anne Mathieu from Quayside Shores Condominiums on Quaboag Pond presented a letter from Fish & Wildlife regarding their concern that the vista

pruning, brush and tree removal might disturb the nesting and breeding of migratory birds. The Massachusetts Endangered Species Association requires Quayside Shores to complete the project review checklist and application and submit the forms with the fee of \$300.00. Mr. Simon assisted in the process of the checklist and application for the project at 108 Brunelle Ave. Quayside Shores cannot begin work until they receive an approval from MESA.

At 7:45p.m. Mr. LaRocca motioned for the approval of the minutes from the May 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 meeting. Mr. Cleveland seconded. All agreed.

At 7:50 p.m. The Commission reviewed the Notice of Intent received through the USPS on June 18, 2013 from Gobi Land Engineering for the repair of the septic system at 3 Marsh View Terrace. Neither the applicant or a representative was present; and no proof of abutter notification nor newspaper ad was presented so a public hearing on this matter was not opened. A site visit will be requested and set-up with Gobi Land Engineering. Mr. Neault is recused from this decision.

At 8:17 p.m. The meeting was adjourned after the motion by Mr. Neault, seconded by Mr.Cleveland, and all agreed.
