Hurricane Sandy after action report

Hurricane Sandy was being monitored as early as Monday, October 22 when the storm was still uncertain, but there was a possibility that it might affect Brookfield.

A test of the Blackboard Direct (reverse 9-1-1 system) was done. As feedback came in, I worked to update those residents that wanted to confirm or expand their coverage.

On Monday, October 29 fire station radio room which acts as the town emergency operations center (EOC) was staffed with an experienced dispatcher from 7am until 8pm.

Conditions were monitored throughout the day by mass media, local radio communications, and area radio communications. Interaction and coordination with FD, EMS, PD, Highway, and National Grid was ongoing during the storm and while power restoration continued

Power was last restored to all areas by 3 pm Thursday, November 1.
