On behalf of Worcester Elevator I would like to thank you for asking us to provide budget estimates for the installation of a passenger elevator in your building located at 6 Central St. Brookfield, MA.

We would be proud to assist you with this project and we hope that we will be able to assist you when the time arises.

At Worcester Elevator, we take pride in providing the highest quality, Non-Proprietary, elevator equipment to our customers. The use of Non-Proprietary equipment ensures that the Contractor receives a product that is price competitive and is completed on schedule and Owner receives the greatest long term value for cost of operation and service. A true winning formula for all parties involved!

Inside the footprint of the existing building:

Option 1: The base option would be the installation of an ADA compliant 2000Lb. Hydraulic Elevator serving the main and second landings. A hoistway (shaft) will need to be constructed that will go from the basement all the way to the roofline of the building. A small machine room will need to be provided in the basement area. Elevator Eqt. Budget \$61,250.00

Option 2: In this option we would install a 2000 Lb. Elevator that will serve the Basement, the Main and the Second floors. The shaft for this elevator would run from the basement all the way to the roofline of the building and will require excavation of the basement to provide a 4' deep elevator pit below the basement level. Elevator Eqt. Budget \$79,500.00

Extensions to building footprint: Changes in the building code require many facilities to incorporate an elevator that is large enough to carry an Ambulance Stretcher, when renovating an existing facility. Such an elevator would have the capacity of 3500 Lbs. And would be large enough to carry a 24" x 84" stretcher in the level position.
