## Selectmen:

The month of April brought an array of calls for the department. We responded to death threats by e-mail made to a party in Brookfield and we are working with another department to secure a criminal application. The department responded to a structure fire on George Allen Rd. in West Brookfield to assist with traffic control.

We have a pending investigation involving several individuals who cut and removed numerous trees from properties in the Rice Corner Rd. area. Three Sex Offenders were registered this month two were Level 3's but were reduced to a level 2 after appeal. The Rte. 148 River Bridge was struck by a box truck and it resulted in serious damage to the bridge. Bartlett Consolidated contacted highway to get the bridge fixed right away.

It maybe coincidental but we have checked on several Disabled Motor Vehicles and the results have been the same, the vehicles are out of gas. Gas prices might have something to do with it. Several officers attended a FREE boating safety course put on by NBPD and the Div. of Fish & Wildlife.


We had numerous court appearances this month. They included MV hearings, Show Cause hearings and trials. The department has been logging any situations at the campground for Town Council.

Sgt. Welsh and I did a walk through at Walker Machine and we will have a report for the Selectmen soon. We also refined the budget a third time and believe with these cuts some training may be in jeopardy. We are also proposing the replacement of cruiser 3103 a front-line vehicle. This vehicle is a First Response Vehicle and is a must. It is not just the fact it is on the Fleet Account for replacement it has high miles and body rot. The

mileage is going to be over 125k by the end of the fiscal year which makes pedestrian and officer safety an issue and a jump in maintenance costs.

The Department had (1) arrest for an individual with multiple felony warrants. The department also had (7) criminal applications for the following... (2) Operating w/o a license, (1) Operating after susp. And poss. of 94c, (3) operating after susp. And unreg., and (1) for reckless operation and marked lanes C-16 @ Bridge.
