Honorable Board of Selectmen,

On January 10<sup>th</sup>, Chief Martell, Highway Superintendent Chaffee and I met with our National Grid representative regarding past/future storm related power outages. The meeting was productive, as we updated Town of Brookfield contact lists, high priority facilities, vulnerable populations and what resources the Town could provide to assist in power restoration efforts.

On January 12<sup>th</sup>, I attended a one day training class on preparing and presenting a budget. This class was offered by Municipal Police Institute Inc and was held at the Grafton Police Department.

On January 26<sup>th</sup>, I was invited to speak to a high school psychology class at Tantasqua Regional High School. I gave a talk on "deviance", which was the current subject being taught. The class consisted of juniors and seniors.
