Honorable Board of Selectmen,

On December 4th, I attended a Chief's In-service class at the Boylston Academy. This was a half day class on updates to legislative issues, such as changes to the Child In Need of Services law or better known as C.H.I.N.S. Due to the change in law, officers are no longer allowed to bring juveniles who violate this law to a police station.

I participated in a school lock down drill for the Quaboag Regional School district. Lock down drills were conducted at the elementary schools in Warren and West Brookfield and Quaboag High Regional High School in Warren. Officers from Warren, West Brookfield and the State Police also participated in the drill.

On December 13th, the Police Department and Library staff held the last of a series of "Pizza Nights" at the library. These events were sponsored by the Brookfield Community Club. We again received a grant from them this year to continue with this program next year. At this last meeting, we sought input from the attendees on how to improve the program for next year.

During the month of December, the Department responded to 267 calls for service. There were two physical arrests and eight criminal summons issued. The members of the Department made seventy-five motor vehicle stops. The following is a breakdown of the calls for services for the month of December;
