SPECIAL TOWN MEETING, JUNE 25, 1970

WORCESTER SS:

To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of Worcester GREETING.

IN THE NAME OF The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Town on Thursday the 25th day of June next, at 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 8:05 P M-Moderator Randall Whitehead in charge.

Voters present --- 48

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to appoint a seven member building committee for the construction of an addition to the Brookfield Elementary School and to act with full and complete authority to obtain firm bids or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to authorize the Selectmen to appoint a seven member building committee for the construction of an addition to Brookfield Elementary School and to act with full and complete authority to obtain firm bids.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money for the cost of architectural services for plans and specifications for an addition to the Elementary School and to provide said appropriation by taxation, by transfer from available funds or by borrowing under the provisions of Clause 21, Section 7, Chapter 44 of the General Laws or take any action relative thereto.

It was unanimously voted to appropriate \$20,000 for the cost of architectural services for plans and specifications for an addition to the Elementary School and to provide said appropriation by transferring \$5000 from available funds in the Treasury and to raise and appropriate \$15,000.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to purchase the Highway Department a new pick up truck and trade the old one in towards it, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$1000 from available funds in the Treasury, the balance to be transferred from the Machinery Fund and Purchase of New Equipment Account, to purchase a new pick-up truck for the Highway Department.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds in the Treasury, a sum of money to be used by the Brookfield Recreation Committee or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from available funds in the Treasury, the sum of \$300 to be used by the Brookfield Recreation Committee.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds in the Treasury a sum of money not to exceed \$700 for the purchase of a new power lawn mower, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from available funds in the Treasury, a sum of money not to exceed \$700 for the purchase of a new power lawn mower.
