To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the  
County of Worcester GREETING.

IN THE NAME OF The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby  
directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified  
to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in  
said Town on Monday the 12th day of July next, at 8:00 o'clock in the  
Afternoon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 8:00 p.m. with moderator, Randall Whitehead  
presiding.

There were 90 voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of  
Health to transfer \$1000.00 (one thousand dollars) from  
the Consultant Engineering Account to the Purchase of  
Land for a Sanitary Landfill Dump Account, or take any  
action relative thereto.

It was voted to authorize the Board of Health to transfer  
\$1,000.00 from the Consultant Engineering Account to  
the Purchase of Land for a Sanitary Landfill Dump Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Town Treasurer  
to sell Tax Title to the Johnson property located on Central  
/Street to the Brookfield Development Corporation.

It was voted to authorize the Town Treasurer to sell the  
Tax Title to the Johnson property located on Central Street  
to the Brookfield Development Corporation for \$1.00.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money  
from available funds in the Treasury to the Youth Guidance  
Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$150.00 from available funds in  
the Treasury to the Youth Guidance Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money  
from available funds in the Treasury to the Common-Mall-  
Christmas Tree Account, or take any action relative  
thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$150.00 from the available funds  
in the Treasury to the Common-Mall-Christmas Tree Account.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of  
money from available funds in the Treasury to the Memorial  
Day Observance Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$121.33 from available funds in  
the Treasury to the Memorial Day Observance Account.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money  
from available funds in the Treasury to the Sewage Expense  
Account, or take any action relative thereto.

VOTE 45 FOR 25 AGAINST

It was voted to transfer \$800.00 from available funds in  
the Treasury to the Sewage Expense Account.

ARTICLE 7. To See if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money  
from available funds in the Treasury to purchase a new  
Three ton cab and chassis heavy-duty truck, or take any  
action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$5,400.00 from available funds  
in the Treasury to purchase and equip a new Three ton  
cab and chassis heavy-duty truck and authorize the Select-  
men to trade in the old cab and chassis.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to accept an amendment to the 'Agreement for Regional School District for the five Towns of Brimfield, Brookfield, Holland, Sturbridge and Wales', dated April 20, 1971, providing for a Transfer of transportation responsibility from the member towns to the Regional School District, in accordance with the provisions of a proposed amendment filed with the selectmen; said amendment having been proposed by the Tantasqua Regional School District pursuant to Article VIII of said Agreement.

It was voted to accept an amendment to the 'Agreement for Regional School District for the five Towns of Brimfield, Brookfield, Holland, Sturbridge and Wales', dated April 20, 1971, providing for a transfer of transportation responsibility from the member towns to the Regional School District, in accordance with the provisions of a proposed amendment filed with the Selectmen; said amendment having been proposed by the Tantasqua Regional School District pursuant to Article VIII of said agreement.
