IN THE NAME OF The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Town on Friday the 18th day of February next, at 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting Called to order at 8:p.m. with moderator, Randall Whitehead presiding.

There were 125 voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money for the enlargement of the elementary school by constructing, originally equipping and furnishing an addition thereto; to determine whether such appropriation shall be raised by taxation, transfer of available funds, borrowing or otherwise; and to take any other action relative thereto.

A motion was made that the sum of \$292,000.00 be and hereby is appropriated for the enlargement of the elementary school by constructing, originally equipping and furnishing an addition thereto; that to meet said appropriation, the Town Treasurer with the approval of the Selectmen is hereby authorized to borrow the sum of \$292,000.00 at one time or from time to time under and pursuant to Chapter 645 of the Acts of 1948, as amended, and to issue bonds or notes of the Town therefore.

An amendment to this motion was made to change the amount of money from \$292,000.00 to \$410,000.00. This would be to include a gymnasium in the addition.

A motion was made to table both amendments until 1973. This was declared out of order and therefore was passed over.

The vote on the amendment to change the amount of money from \$292,000.00 to \$410,000.00 was
