ARTICLE 35. To see if the Town will authorize the Board of Selectmen to amend the existing contract with Green Engineering Affiliates to provide for the scope of services in connection with the planning, design and construction of a secondary type sewage plant and a sewage collection system to serve the area lying between Main Street and Lincoln Street, the payments for such services to be rendered under said contract to be made from such sums as may be acquired or appropriated for the capital costs of said facilities, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over Articles 32, 33, 34 and 35.

ARTICLE 36. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Assessors to use a sum of money from available funds in the Treasury for the reduction of the Tax Levy of 1972, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to authorize the Assessors to use \$20,000.00 from available funds in the Treasury for the reduction of the Tax Levy for 1972.

ARTICLE 37. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money for the Stabilization Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted that nothing would be appropriated for the Stabilization Account.
