To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of Worcester
GREETING.

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Town on Monday the 25th day of September next, at 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 8:pm with 162 voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the Treasury to the General Highway Snow and Ice Account \$7,000.00 - or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$7,000.00 from available funds in the Treasury to the General Highway Snow and Ice Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to have the Town Clerk in the Town Hall Monday, Wednesday and Friday from one to four p.m., and one night from seven to ten p.m. at a salary of \$40.00 per week, or take any action relative thereto.

As pointed out in Chapter 41 Sec. 108, The Town Clerk salary can only be changed at an Annual Town Meeting, therefore this article voted down.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the Treasury \$250.00 to cover the increased salary of the Town Clerk's additional hours from October 1 to December 31, of this year.

It was voted to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to approve or disapprove the amount of debt, aggregating \$275,000 in principal amount, authorized on August 28, 1972 by the Tantasqua Regional District School Committee for the purpose of financing in part an addition to the regional high school consisting of the construction and equipping of a regional junior high School for grades 7, 8 and 9, including architect's and engineering fees and other costs incidental thereto.

It was voted to approve the amount of debt, aggregating \$275,000 in principal amount, authorized on August 28, 1972 by the Tantasqua Regional District School Committee for the purpose of financing in part an addition to the regional high school consisting of the construction and equipping of a regional junior high school for grades 7, 8 and 9, including architect's and engineering fees and other costs incidental thereto.
