SPECIAL TOWN MEETING, MAY 10, 1974

WORCESTER SS.

To either of the Constables of the TOWN of BROOKFIELD in the County of WORCESTER GREETING.

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the TOWN HALL in said TOWN on FRIDAY the 10th day of MAY next, at 7:15 o'clock in the AFTER noon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

The meeting opened at 7:15 P.M., Moderator, Randall Whitehead presiding. 175 voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Town Hall Expense Account to the Municipal Fuel Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$3,093.29 from the Town Hall Expense Account to the Municipal Fuel Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to accept the sum of \$32,800.00 made available from a bond issue approved by the General Court as Chapter 1140 of the Acts of 1973, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted that the Town accept the sum of \$32,800.00 made available from a bond issue approved by the General Court as Chapter 1140 of the Acts of 1973.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to accept the sum of \$19,680.00 made available from a bond issue approved by the General Court as Chapter 1140 of the Acts of 1973, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted that the Town accept the sum of \$19,680.00 made available from a bond issue approved by the General Court as Chapter 1140 of the Acts of 1973.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the General Highway & Snow & Ice Account to the Highway Chapter 81 Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$1,825.00 from the General Highway & Snow & Ice Account to the Highway Chapter 81 Account.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will assume liability in the manner provided by Section 29 of Chapter 91 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by Chapter 5, Acts of 1955, for all damages that may be incurred by work performed by the Department of Public Works of Massachusetts for the improvement, development, maintenance and protection of tidal and non-tidal rivers and streams, harbors, tidewaters, foreshores along a public beach, including the Merrimac and Connecticut Rivers, in accordance with Section 11 of Chapter 91 of the General Laws, and authorize the Selectmen to execute and deliver a bond of indemnity therefore to the Commonwealth, or take any action relative thereto.

This article was defeated.

Meeting adjourned at 7:30 P.M.
