IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the TOWN HALL AUDITORIUM in said TOWN on MONDAY, the 15th day of JULY next, at 8:00 P.M. O'clock in the AFTER noon, then and there to act on the following articles:

The meeting opened at 8:00 P.M. Moderator, Randall Whitehead presiding.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote, by secret written ballot, to instruct the Board of Selectmen to order the Chief of Police to maintain the Police Headquarters in the town hall or some other municipal building in Brookfield or take any action relative thereto.

This article was amended to read, To see if the town will vote in favor of maintaining the police department in the town hall or some other municipal building in the town.

This article as amended was defeated by a ballot vote.
The vote was 169 yes
190 no.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to instruct the Board of Health to act in a negative manner on the request of National Waste Systems Inc. for a permit to operate a sanitary landfill in the Town of Brookfield, Mass. or take any action relative thereto.

At the request of the Board of Health chairman, Edward F. Stearns, this article was tabled until more information could be obtained about the landfill operation.

Meeting adjourned at 10:30 P.M.
