- (A) Deleting the word "may" and inserting the word "will" and
- (B) Deleting "\$1.00" and inserting "\$1.00 per \$1,000 valuation of new construction and/or alterations with a minimum \$1.00 fee" so that the By-Law will read:

"No building or other structure after these By-Laws go into effect shall be constructed, removed or materially altered without first obtaining a permit therefor from the Building Inspector. Plans and specifications will be required by the Building Inspector before such permit is issued. The fee for such permit shall be \$1.00 per \$1,000.00 valuation of new construction and/or alteration with a minimum \$1.00 fee. No charge will be made to remove a structure except the minimum \$1.00 permit fee.

An amendment was moved and seconded on this Article so that it read to see if the Town will vote to amend our Building Permit By-Law Chapter XII, Section 4 by

- (A) Deleting the word "may" and inserting the Word "will" and
- (B) Deleting "\$1.00" and inserting "\$1.00 per \$1,000 valuation of new construction and/or alterations with a minimum \$1.00 fee. No charge will be made to remove a structure except the minimum \$1.00 permit fee." so that the By-Law will read:

ARTICLE 11. To see if the Town will vote to establish a Building Permit Fund or take any action relative thereto.

ARTICLE 12. To see if the Town will vote to have all fees collected from the issuance of Building Permits and Building Inspections revert to the Building Permit Fund or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over this article.
