GREETING.

In the name of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Brookfield on Friday, the fifth day of May next, at seven-thirty o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following articles:- The meeting opened @ 7:30 P.M., James W. Allen, moderator. 92 voters present.
ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$317.44 from available funds in the treasury to the Elections and Registrations Account to pay the cost of the Special Town Election held on November 8, 1977, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to accept the sum of \$1,075.00 received as payment for damage to the 1973 Ford Cruiser, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to accept the sum of \$1,075.00 received as payment for damage to the 1973 Ford Cruiser and ~~transfer it to the~~ Police Dept. Account.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the treasury, the sum of \$6,153.00 to the Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$2,000.00 from the Group Insurance Account, \$3,000.00 from Veterans" Benefits Case Work and \$5,733.29 from Overlay Reserve (total sum of \$10,733.29 to be transferred) to the Insurance Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the treasury the sum of \$990.00 for a radar unit for the Police Department, said sum of money to be 100% reimburseable by the Governors Highway Safety Council, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from Overlay Reserve, the sum of \$990.00 for a radar unit for the Police Department, said sum of money to be 100% reimburseable by the Governors Highway Safety Council.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$10,903.00 in Anti-recession funds to the General Highway Snow and Ice Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$10,903.00 in Anti-recession funds to the General Highway Snow and Ice Account.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds in the treasury to the Highway Snow and Ice Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over this article.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from available funds in the treasury for use by the Historical Commission to purchase a marker for the Joshua Spooner site, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$200.00 from Overlay Reserve to the Historical Commission for the purchase of a marker for the Joshua Spooner site.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the treasury the sum of \$240.00 to the "Agent to Defend Suits" account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from Overlay Reserve, the sum of \$240.00 to the "Agent to Defend Suits" account.

The Meeting adjourned at 7:45 P.M.
