County of Worcester GREETING.

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to Vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Banquet Hall in said Town on Monday the fifth day of March next at 7:30 o'clock in the after noon, then and there to act on the following articles:

Meeting opened at 7:30 P.M., James Allen, Moderator presiding.
40 voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money received from the Anti-Recession Fiscal Assistance Program to the General Highway & Snow & Ice Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$3,143.81 received from the Anti-Recession Fiscal Assistance Program to the General Highway & Snow & Ice Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from Available Funds in the Treasury for the purpose of purchasing Veterans' Graves Markers, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from available funds in the treasury the sum of \$275.00 for the purpose of purchasing Veterans' Grave Markers.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Available Funds in the Treasury, the sum of \$600.00 for the purchase of one 50 watt output used Mocom 70 Motorola Radio with accessories and installation for the Police Dept., or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from Available Funds in the Treasury the sum of \$600.00 for the purpose of purchasing one 50 watt output used Mocom 70 Motorola Radio with accessories and installation for the Dodge Monaco Police cruiser.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from Available Funds in the Treasury to the Printing And Mailing of Town Reports Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from Available Funds in the Treasury, the sum of \$150.00 to the Printing & Mailing of Town Reports Account.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to accept a \$1,000.00 donation from the Greater Worcester County Foundation and transfer it to a fund for the Beautification and Improvement of the Town Common & Mall, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to accept the sum of \$1,000.00 donated by the Greater Worcester County Foundation and transfer it to a fund for the Beautification and Improvement of the Town Common.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to accept a donation of \$400.00 from the VFW AUXILLARY and transfer it to the PURCHASE OF A NEW AMBULANCE ACCOUNT, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to accept the sum of \$400.00 donated by the VFW Auxillary and place it in the Purchase of a New Ambulance Account. A request was made that the clerk record that the Town is sincerely grateful for the donation and accepts it with thanks.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to accept the total of \$650.00 from various donations and transfer them to the Highway Department for the purchase of C.B. radios for the highway vehicles, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to accept the sum of \$650.00 received from various donations and transfer them to the General Highway & Snow & Ice Account for the purpose of purchasing C.B. radios for the highway vehicles.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to accept the sum of \$140.00 from Philip L. Buxton, Inc. and transfer it to the Highway Machinery Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to accept the sum of \$140.40 received from Philip L. Buxton, Inc. and transfer it to the Highway Machinery Account.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to accept a check for \$250.00 received from Aetna Insurance Co. as payment for damages to guardrails on Quaboag Street and transfer it to the General Highway & Snow & Ice Account or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to accept the check from Aetna Insurance Co. in the amount of \$250.00 for damages done to guardrails on Quaboag St. and transfer it to the General Highway & Snow & Ice Account.

Meeting adjourned at 8:00 P.M.
