IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the TOWN HALL in said Town on FRIDAY, the eleventh day of May next, at 7:30 o'clock in the after noon then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 7:35 P.M., approx. 60 voters present. James W. Allen, moderator presiding.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE TREASURY to the TOWN HALL ACCOUNT or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,500.00 from the OVERLAY SURPLUS ACCOUNT to the TOWN HALL ACCOUNT.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the LIBRARY EXTENSION ACCOUNT (GRANT FROM THE STATE) to the PUBLIC LIBRARY ACCOUNT, or take any action relative thereto .

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$815.63 from the LIBRARY EXTENSION ACCOUNT (GRANT FROM THE STATE) to the PUBLIC LIBRARY ACCOUNT.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$179.10 from AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE TREASURY to the WATER DEPARTMENT ACCOUNT or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made and voted that the transfer be made from the SALE OF USED METALS ACCOUNT. It was then voted to transfer the sum of \$179.10 from the SALE OF USED METALS ACCOUNT to the WATER DEPARTMENT ACCOUNT.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$3,754.60 from AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE TREASURY FOR interest on water department loans, or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made and voted that the transfer be made from the OVERLAY SURPLUS ACCOUNT. It was then voted to transfer the sum of \$3,754.60 from the OVERLAY SURPLUS ACCOUNT to the INTEREST ON WATER DEPARTMENT LOAN ACCOUNT.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to appoint a committee to investigate and make recommendations for an appropriate symbol, to be used by the Town for the unique identification of the Town as a landmark, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to authorize the Selectmen to appoint a committee to investigate and make recommendations for an appropriate symbol to be used by the Town, for the unique identification of the Town as a landmark.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE TREASURY to the TOWN INSURANCE FUND or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made and voted that the transfer be made from the Overlay Surplus Account. It was then voted to transfer \$4,000.00 from the OVERLAY SURPLUS ACCOUNT to the TOWN INSURANCE FUND.

At the Annual Town Meeting held on May 11, 1979, the following By-Laws were voted subject to your approval:

ARTICLE 11. It was voted to amend our Town By-Law, Chapter XII, Section 1.5 by changing the amount \$10.00 to read \$50.00 so that the amended section will read "any owner found in violation of any of the provisions of this by-law shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.00 in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 140 Section 173A of the Mass. General Laws."

ARTICLE 17. It was voted to accept a By-Law to be Chapter 12, Section 2.1 to read:  
All regular Town employees(excluding School Personnel) working a minimum of 30 hours per week shall be granted sick days without loss of pay, said sick days to be computed in the following manner: After 1 year of service: six sick days to be granted each year, accumulative to thirty days.

ARTICLE 16. It was voted to amend Chapter XII, Section 2 of the Town By-Laws by deleting sub-sections A. B & C and replacing them by the following:

For one year's service but less than two years' service a vacation of one week.

For two years' service but less than ten years' service a vacation of two weeks.

For ten years' service but less than twenty years' service, a vacation of three weeks.

For twenty years' service and more, a vacation of four weeks.


