To either of the Constables of the Town of BROOKFIELD in the County
of Worcester **GREETING.**

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall Auditorium in said Town on Friday the 9th day of May next, at 7:00 o'clock in the after noon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M. 151 voters present James W. Allen Moderator, presiding.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Available Funds in the Treasury the sum of \$379.00 to cover the cost of the State Primary held on March 4, 1980 or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from Overlay Surplus, the sum of 379.00 to cover the cost of the State Primary held on March 4, 1980.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$4,000.00 from Available Funds in the Treasury to the Municipal Fuel Account or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of 3,439.56 from the Overlay Surplus to the Municipal Fuel Account.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$3,000.00 from available funds in the Treasury to the Water Department for corrective p.h. control or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$3,000.00 from Overlay Surplus to the Water Department Maintenance & Operation Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$1,200.00 from Available Funds in the Treasury to the Library Account or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,200.00 from Overlay Surplus to the Library Account.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$10,000.00 from the General Highway Snow and Ice Account to the Highway Machinery Fund and Purchase of New Equipment Account or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made to amend the amount to \$5,000.00. It was then voted to transfer \$5,000.00 from the General Highway Snow and Ice Account to the Highway Machinery Account.

ARTICLE #6. To see if the Town will vote to join the Worcester Regional Transit Authority or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to join the Worcester Regional Transit Authority.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$75.00 from Available Funds in the Treasury to the Council on the Arts or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$75.00 from the Field Driver Expense Account to the Council on the Arts.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town of Brookfield will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to petition the General Court for the purpose of establishing a Rent Control Law for Mobile Home Parks in the Town of Brookfield or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made that the rent control law should cover all rental properties in the Town of Brookfield. This amendment was defeated. It was then voted not to authorize the Board of Selectmen to petition the General Court for the purpose of establishing a Rent Control Law for Mobile Home Parks in the Town of Brookfield. Vote Yes 55

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$1,400.00 from Available Funds in the Treasury for the purchase of a new radio for the ambulance or take any action relative thereto.

Voted to transfer from Free Cash the sum of \$560.00 for a radio for the ambulance and \$840.00 to the deficient budget of the Rescue Squad.

It was voted to increase the appropriation limit established by Chapter 151 of the Acts of 1979 for fiscal 1980 by \$14,066.38 so that the total limit so increased will be \$835,951.54. Vote was unanimous.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof at TOWN HALL, POST OFFICE, FRAZIER'S NEWS in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meeting

HEREOF FAIL NOT, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting, as aforesaid.
