IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the TOWN HALL AUDITORIUM in said BROOKFIELD on Monday the Fifteenth day of November next at 7:00 o'clock in the After noon, then and there to act on the following articles:- Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M. James W. Allen, Moderator. 81 Voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$65.00 from Interest-Temporary Loans Account to Certification of Notes Account or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$65.00 from the Contributory Insurance Account to Certification of Notes Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$4,827.69 from Available Funds in the Treasury to the Group Insurance Account to make up for deficits from the past two years due to underfunding or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to Raise and Appropriate the sum of \$4,827.69 for the Group Insurance Account to make up for deficits from the past two years due to underfunding.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$217.15 from Available Funds in the Treasury to the 1975 Census Account or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to Raise and Appropriate \$217.15 for the 1975 Census Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$2,644.22 from Elder Bus Contract authorized from #92-512 Account to General Highway or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$2,644.22 from Elder Bus Contract-(Fed. Rev.) Authorized from #92-512 to the General Highway Account.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from Available Funds in the Treasury the sum of \$225.00 to purchase siding and paint for the dog pound or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$225.00 to purchase paint and siding for the dog pound.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$3,190.90 from Available Funds in the Treasury to the Interest-Maturing Debt Account to cover interest on Pine Lane Extension and New Highway Loader loans of last year or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made and voted to transfer the sum of \$1,190.90 from Interest-Temporary Loans Account to the Interest Maturing Debt Account to cover interest on the Pine Lane Extension and New Highway Loader loans of last year.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$752.79 from Available Funds in the Treasury to the Withholding Interest Account or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made to raise and appropriate \$752.79 for the Withholding Interest Account. This motion was defeated.

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or transfer from Available Funds in the Treasury the sum of \$2,000.00 for the purchase of a copy machine for the Town Hall or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from Federal Revenue Sharing Funds the sum of \$2,000 to purchase a copy machine for the Town Hall.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to adopt the following resolution: Be it resolved that the Town meeting of Brookfield supports its local officials' and residents' participation in the investigation and correction of the ecological problems existing in Quaboag and Quacumquasit Lakes and watershed areas in the Town of Brookfield and in the pursuit of grants to fund these endeavors or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted that the Town adopt the following resolution: Be it resolved that the Town meeting of Brookfield supports its local officials' and residents' participation in the investigation and correction of the ecological problems existing in Quaboag and Quacumquasit Lakes and watershed areas in the Town of Brookfield and in the pursuit of grants to fund these endeavors. Vote was unanimous.

ARTICLE 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from Available Funds in the Treasury the sum of 2,500.00 to be used by the Selectmen for general repair of the Town Hall and supportive buildings or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from Federal Revenue Sharing Funds the sum of \$2,000.00 to be used by the Selectmen for general repair of the Town Hall and supportive buildings.

ARTICLE 11. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Federal Revenue Sharing funds to the Police Department budget the sum of \$643.50 for reimbursement of funds used to purchase a light bar for the police cruiser or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from previously voted Federal Revenue Sharing Funds to the Police Department budget the sum of \$643.50 for reimbursement of funds used to purchase a light bar for the police cruiser.

ARTICLE 12. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Available Funds in the Treasury, to the Highway Machinery Account the sum of \$450.00 received as insurance reimbursement for damage to the Highway Department lawnmower or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from Available Funds in the Treasury to the Highway Machinery Account the sum of \$450.00 received as insurance reimbursement for damage to the Highway Department lawnmower.

ARTICLE 13. To see if the Town will vote to rescind ARTICLE 4 of the Special Town Meeting held on April 23, 1973 which authorized the Board of Selectmen, with the approval of the Advisory Board and Planning Board and also Conservation Commission, to sell the balance (10 acres) of the Lewis Site for industrial or commercial purposes or for the best interests of the Town and transfer the 10 acres to the Recreation Committee for the purpose of development of a Recreational Park or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over ARTICLE 13.

ARTICLE 14. To see if the Town will vote to raise by taxation, appropriate, or borrow or transfer from Available Funds in the Treasury the sum of \$22,148.39 to supplement the Brookfield Elementary School budget for unanticipated special education and transportation costs or take any action relative thereto.

This article was defeated and it was voted not to appropriate the sum of \$22,148.39 to supplement the Brookfield Elementary School budget for unanticipated special education and transportation costs. Vote was
