To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of Worcester  
GREETING

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall Auditorium in said Brookfield on Tuesday, the twenty second day of March next, at 8:00 o'clock in the after noon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 8:00 P.M. James W. Allen, moderator. 100 Voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the amount of \$6,638.00 to supplement the elementary school budget for unforeseen special education costs or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted, upon receipt from the state, to transfer from available funds in the treasury the sum of \$6,638.00 to supplement the elementary school budget for unforeseen special education costs.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, borrow or transfer from available funds in the treasury the amount of \$22,628.00 to supplement the elementary school budget for unforeseen special education costs or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$12,000.00 from free cash and to transfer \$4,000.00 from the Municipal Fuel Account to supplement the elementary school budget for unforeseen special education costs.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds, the sum of \$500.00 for the Housing Authority to conduct a preliminary survey in accordance with state regulations for acquisition of funding under Chapter 667 for elderly housing or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$500.00 from the Municipal Fuel Account to the Housing Authority Account to conduct a preliminary survey in accordance with state regulations for acquisition of funding under Chapter 667 for elderly housing.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to adopt the following resolution:  
Be it resolved that the Town Meeting of Brookfield supports its local officials' and residents' participation in the investigation and correction of the ecological problems existing in Mill Pond and in the pursuit of grants to fund these endeavors or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to adopt the following resolution:
