IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Brookfield on Monday the 12th day of March next, at 7:00 1'clock in the after noon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M., James Allen, moderator presiding. 79 Voters present

Article 1. To see if the town will vote to transfer the sum of \$202.73 received from Massachusetts Electric Co. from available funds to the Water Department Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over Article 1.

Article 2. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow the sum of \$2,000.00 for drainage for the highway yard, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer from the Municipal Fuel Account the sum of \$2,000.00 for drainage for the highway yard.

Article 3. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow from available funds the sum of \$2,657.21 to pay to the town of Abington, Mass the Town of Brookfield's portion of benefits paid to Leonard Palopoli due as a result of services rendered to the Town of Brookfield in the years 1931-40, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over Article 3.

Article 4. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow the sum of \$3,122.08 for the Interest - Temporary Loans Account or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$3,122.08 from the Veterans Benefits-Casework Account to the Interest - Temporary Loans Account.

Article 5. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow the sum of \$6,000.00 for the Group Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over Article 5.

Article 6. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow the sum of \$4,500.00 for the Contributory Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over Article 6.

Article 7. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow the sum of \$752.79 for the Withholding - Interest Account or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$752.79 from the Veterans Benefits-Casework Account to the Withholding - Interest Account.

Article 8. To see if the town will vote to request that the Board of Selectmen petition the Legislature for the purpose of seeking a special legislative act to provide for the recall and removal of any elected official and removal election in the Town of Brookfield, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to request that the Board of Selectmen petition the Legislature for the purpose of seeking a special legislative act to provide for the recall and removal of any elected official and removal elections in the Town of Brookfield. This article passed favorably on a voice vote.

Article 9. To see if the town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$72,000.00 for an approved school project under Chapter 645 of the Acts of 1948, as amended, consisting of the remodeling, replacement, renovation or modernization of the heating system of the Brookfield Elementary School by the purchase and installation of new boilers and related work, such sum to be transferred from the unexpended balance of bond proceeds remaining after completion of the Elementary School enlargement project authorized under Article 1 of the Warrant for the Special Town Meeting held on February 1, 1972 or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to appropriate the sum of \$72,000.00 for an approved school project under Chapter 645 of the Acts of 1948, as amended, consisting of the remodeling, replacement, renovation or modernization of the heating system of the Brookfield Elementary School by the purchase and installation of new boilers and related work, such sum to be transferred from the unexpended balance of bond proceeds remaining after completion of the Elementary School enlargement project authorized under Article 1 of the Warrant for the Special Town Meeting held on February 18, 1972. Vote was unanimous.

Meeting adjourned at 7:35 P.M.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof at Town Hall, Post Office and Fraziers News in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meeting.
