

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
May 11, 1984

WORCESTER.....SS

To either of the Constables of the Town of BROOKFIELD in the County of
WORCESTER GREETING.

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall, Central Street in said Brookfield on Friday, the eleventh day of May next, at 7:00 o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M., James W. Allen, Moderator presiding. 57 Voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Group Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$4,849.12 from the Elementary School Account to the Group Insurance Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Contributory Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$2,000.00 from the Elementary School Account and \$1,000.00 from the Tree Warden Account to the Contributory Insurance Account.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow the sum of \$856.41 to the Interest-Maturing Debt Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over ARTICLE 3.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow the sum of \$2,657.21 for the Abington Retirement System or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made to transfer the sum of \$2,000.00 from the Cemetery Expenses account and the sum of \$657.21 from the Emergency Squad Expenses Account to pay the Town of Abington, Mass., the Town of Brookfield's share of benefits paid to Leonard Palopoli due as a result of services rendered to the Town of Brookfield in the years 1931-1940 and that the Town through its Board of Selectmen extend its best wishes on the occasion of Mr. Palopoli's 75th birthday on May 23, 1984. An amendment to the motion to transfer the funds from School Expenses because he was a teacher was defeated. It was voted to transfer the sum of \$2,000.00 from the Cemetery Expenses Account and the sum of \$657.21 from the Emergency Squad Expenses Account to pay the Town of Abington, Mass, the Town of Brookfield's share of benefits paid to Leonard Palopoli due as a result of services rendered to the Town of Brookfield in the years 1931-1940 and that the Town through its Board of Selectmen extend its best wishes on the occasion of Mr. Palopoli's 75th birthday on May 23, 1984.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to amend sub-section 2 of Section 7 of Chapter 14 of the By-Laws of the Town of Brookfield by deleting said sub-section 2 and replacing it with the following sub-section 2: "Pursuant to Chapter 616 of the Acts of 1982, the Western Worcester Division of the District court Department shall have original jurisdiction, concurrently with the Superior Court, of All petitions for review brought pursuant to section 14 of Chapter 30A of the General Laws;" or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to amend sub-section 2 of Section 7 of Chapter 14 of the By-Laws of the Town of Brookfield by deleting said sub-section 2 and replacing it with the following sub-section 2: "Pursuant to Chapter 616 of the Acts of 1982, the Western Worcester Division of the District Court Department shall have original jurisdiction, concurrently with the Superior Court, of all petitions for review brought pursuant to section 14 of Chapter 30A of the General Laws.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Accounting Officer's expense account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over ARTICLE 6.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Town Hall Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over ARTICLE 7.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Dog Officer's Expense Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over ARTICLE 8.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Community Health Nursing Program Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over ARTICLE 9.

ARTICLE 10. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer to the Insurance Account the sums of \$5,000.00 from the Municipal Fuel Account, \$1,000.00 from the Police Dept. Expenses Account, \$1,000.00 from the Library's Expenses Account, \$500.00 from the Board of Health's Expenses Account, \$500.00 from The Fire Dept. Expenses Account, \$300.00 from the Civil Defense Account, \$300.00 from the Highway Department's Bathroom Account, \$150.00 from the Tax Collector's Expenses Account and \$25.00 from the Elementary School Account. Total of \$8,775.00.

ARTICLE 11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow the sum of \$1,000.00 to be used to pay a consultant for the Board of Assessors to update file information, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over ARTICLE 11. Meeting adjourned at 7:25 P.M

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof at Town Hall, Post Office and Fraziers News in said Town fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meeting. HEREOF FAIL NOT, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting, as aforesaid.
