To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of  
WORCESTER GREETING.

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Brookfield on Wednesday, the 27th day of June next, at 7:00 o'clock in the after noon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M. James W. Allen, Moderator, presiding. 40 voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for extra duty Police salaries incurred as a result of the flood during the days of June 1, 1984 to June 4, 1984, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to pass over Article 1.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Town Hall Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$588.41 from the Municipal Fuel Account to the Town Hall Expenses Account.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Library Expenses Account to the Library Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$244.38 from the Library Expenses Account to the Library Salary Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Street Light Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$600.00 from the Emergency Squad Expenses Account and the sum of \$88.16 from the Municipal Fuel Account to the Street Light Account.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Plowing of Private Roads Account to the General Highway Snow and Ice Salary Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer \$1,000.00 from the Plowing Private Roads Account to the General Highway Snow and Ice Expenses Account.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate, transfer or borrow the sum of \$625.00 for the 1985 Census, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$625.00 for the 1985 State Census.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate an additional sum of \$20,000.00 for an approved school project under Chapter 645 of the Acts of 1948, as amended, consisting of remodeling, replacement, renovation or modernization of the Brookfield Elementary School by the purchase of new boilers and related work, such sum to be transferred from the unexpended balance of the bond proceeds remaining after completion of the Elementary School enlargement project authorized under Article 1 for the Special Town Meeting held on February 18, 1972, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to appropriate an additional sum of \$20,000.00 for an approved school project under Chapter 645 of the Acts of 1948, as amended, consisting of remodeling, replacement, renovation or modernization of the Brookfield Elementary School by the purchase of new boilers and related work, such sum to be transferred from the unexpended balance of the bond proceeds

remaining after completion of the Elementary School enlargement project authorized under Article 1 for the Special Town Meeting held on February 18, 1972.

Meeting adjourned at 7:10 P.M.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof at the Town Hall, Frazier's News, and Post Office, in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meeting.

HEREOF FAIL NOT, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting, as aforesaid.
