IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall Auditorium in said Town on Tuesday the eleventh day of September next at 7:00 o'clock in the after noon then and there to act on the following articles;-

Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M. James W. Allen, Moderator presiding. 110 voters were present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to accept all monies donated to the Merrick Public Library in memory of Elsie Merriam and to transfer such funds from the General Funds to the Merrick Public Library Book Account, or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made to accept all monies donated to the Merrick Public Library in memory of Elsie Merriam and to transfer such funds from the General Funds to the Merrick Public Library Book Account. This motion was amended to specify that the sum donated to date as \$340.00. It was voted to accept \$340.00 that was donated to the Merrick Public Library in memory of Elsie Merriam and to transfer such funds from the General Funds to the Merrick Public Library Book Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Special Town Election to be held on September 10, 1984, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$374.22 for the Special Town Election held on Monday, September 10, 1984.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of \$200.00 to be paid to Brookfield Cablevision, Inc. and Greater Worcester Cablevision, Inc. for reimbursement of Cable Television application fees, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$200.00 from available funds to reimburse Brookfield Cablevision, Inc. and Greater Worcester Cablevision, Inc. for application fees paid to the town.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for necessary repairs to the Fire Department's tanker truck, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$3,000.00 for necessary repairs to the Fire Department's tanker truck.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to obtain easements for the reconstruction of Route 148, or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made to raise and appropriate the sum of \$25,000.00 to obtain easements for the reconstruction of Route 148. This article was defeated

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to reimburse Mary Leach for health insurance, or take any action relative thereto.

It was vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,346.10 to reimburse Mary Leach for health insurance.
