To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of
Worcester GREETING.

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Brookfield on Tuesday, the 16th day of October next, at 7:00 o'clock in the after noon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M., Town Clerk, Leamana Terry, presiding. Nominations were called for a temporary moderator to replace James Allen who was absent. Diane Martell was nominated and voted to be temporary moderator. 103 Voters present.

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to conduct a required update of all properties in town, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$9,150.00 to conduct a required update of all properties in town.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to pay unpaid bills for fiscal year 1983-84, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,364.71 from the Audit Account to pay unpaid bills for fiscal year 1983-84.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer \$1000.00 from the Audit Account to the Selectmen's Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Audit Account to the Selectmen's Expenses Account.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for appraisals, land acquisition of the southerly portion of Route 148 or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made to raise and appropriate the sum of \$25,000 for appraisals, land acquisition, eminent domain takings and engineering services for the reconstruction of the southerly portion of Route 148. A request was made that it be entered into the record that no vote should be taken until town counsel ruled it legal. An amendment to the motion to require the Selectmen to send a letter of protest to the Department of Public Works listing specific complaints was defeated 45 to 23. It was then voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$25,000.00 for appraisals, land acquisition, eminent domain takings and engineering services for the reconstruction of the southerly portion of Route 148. Vote was 64 In Favor 39 Opposed. by a secret Meeting adjourned at 9:57 P.M. ballot.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof at Post Office, Frazier's News and Town Hall in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meeting.

HEREOF FAIL NOT, and make due return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting, as aforesaid.
