To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of
Worcester GREETING.

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Brookfield on Monday, the fourteenth day of January next, at seven o'clock in the after noon, then and there to act on the following articles;

Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M., James W. Allen, Moderator, presiding. 35 voters present.

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to amend Chapter V, section 1 of its By-Laws by deleting the present wording in its entirety and replacing such section with the following new wording: "An audit of the accounts of the Town shall be made at least one every three years in accordance with Federal Revenue Sharing regulations", or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to amend Chapter V. Section 1 of its By-Laws by deleting the present wording in its entirety and replacing such section with the following new wording: "An audit of the accounts of the Town shall be made at least once every three years in accordance with Federal Revenue Sharing regulations." The vote was unanimous.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow the sum of \$1,875.00 for the 1985 State Census, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,875.00 from Free Cash for the 1985 State Census.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the Fire Department salary/wages account the sum of \$1,100.00 to the Fire Department expenses account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,100.00 from the Fire Dept. Salary/Wages to the Fire Dept. Expenses Account.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to amend line item 7a of Article 2 of the May 11, 1984 Annual Town Meeting so as to provide that the Assessors' salaries shall be as follows: \$45.00 per month for each Assessor and \$4.00 per hour for office work and field work provided by each Assessor, or take any action relative thereto.

A motion was made and voted to amend line item 7a of Article 2 of the May 11, 1984 Annual Town Meeting so as to provide that the Assessors' salaries for Fiscal Year 1985 be as follows: Chairman - 107.33 per month; Clerk - \$98.00 per month; Third Member - 78.00 per month.

Vote was 29 In Favor 0 Opposed.

Meeting adjourned at 7:10 P.M.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant, by posting up attested copies thereof at the Town Hall, Frazier's News and Post Office, in said Town, fourteen days at least before the time of holding siad meeting.
