

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
May 10, 1985

To either of the Constables of the Town of Brookfield in the County of
WORCESTER GREETING

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the TOWN HALL in said Brookfield on Friday the tenth day of May next, at seven o'clock in the after noon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M. James W. Allen, moderator presiding.
30 voters present.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Contributory Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$375.00 from Free Cash to the Contributory Insurance Account.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Town Hall Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Municipal Fuel Account to the Town Hall Expenses Account.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Printing By-Laws Account to the Printing Town Reports Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$71.00 from the Printing By-Laws Account to the Printing Town Reports Account.

ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Insurance Account to cover the costs of increased premiums for the Municipality Fleet Policy, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$7,475.00 from the Municipal Fuel Account to the Insurance Account to cover costs of increased premiums for municipal insurance.

ARTICLE 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$224.00 from Free Cash to the Police Department budget, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$224.00 from Free Cash to the Police Department Expense budget.

ARTICLE 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Water Superintendent's Salary Account to the Water Department Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,900.00 from the Water Superintendents Salary Account to the Water Department Expenses Account.

ARTICLE 7. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to dispose of town property by auction, tag sale or sealed bids, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to authorize the Board of Selectmen to dispose of town property by auction, tag sale or sealed bids.

ARTICLE 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Assessors' Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$860.00 from Free Cash to the Assessors' Expenses Account.

ARTICLE 9. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Veterans' Casework Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$9,376.00 from the Overlay Reserve Account to the Veterans' Casework Account.

ARTICLE 10. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Plowing Private Roads Account to the General Highway Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Plowing Private Roads Account to the General Highway Expenses Account.

ARTICLE 11. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to the Police Department Expenses Account for the purpose of reimbursing legal fees incurred in the Weingarten vs. Olson case, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$513.95 from Free Cash to the Police Department Expenses Account for the purpose of reimbursing legal fees incurred in the Weingarten vs. Olson case.

ARTICLE 12. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Group Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto.

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$5,205.00 to come from the following accounts: \$2,866.67 from the Interest on Temporary Loans Account and \$2,338.33 from the Overlay Reserve Account to the Group Insurance Account.

Meeting adjourned at 7:22 P.M.
