GREETING.

IN THE NAME OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Brookfield on Thursday, the twenty-seventh of June next, at seven o'clock in the after noon, then and there to act on the following articles:-

Meeting opened at 7:00 P.M., James W. Allen, Moderator presiding. 35 voters present.

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer a sum of money from the Assessors' Salary Account to the Assessors' Expenses Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Assessors).

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$170.00 from the Assessors' Salary Account to the Assessors' Expenses Account.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money as the Town's share of a state Greenway grant for the Quaboag River, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen).

It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$900.00 as the Town's share of a state Greenway grant for the Quaboag River.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the Agent to Defend Suits Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health).

It was voted to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,000.00 for the Agent to Defend Suits Account.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to supplement the Group Insurance Account, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Selectmen).

It was voted to transfer the sum of \$1,000.00 from the Municipal Fuel Account and \$1,411.00 from Free Cash, for a total of \$2,411.00, to the Insurance Account.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to increase the salary of the Gas Inspector (Line Item #21a of Article #2 of the May 10, 1985 Annual Town Meeting) from \$250.00 to \$500.00, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health).

It was voted to raise and appropriate \$250.00 for the purpose of increasing the salary of the Gas Inspector from \$250.00 to \$500.00 per year. (Line Item #21a of Article #2 of the May 10, 1985 Annual Town Meeting).

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to increase the salary of the Plumbing Inspector (Line Item #22a of Article #2 of the May 10, 1985 Annual Town Meeting) from \$250.00 to 500.00 or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Board of Health)

It was voted to raise and appropriate \$250.00 for the purpose of increasing the salary of the Plumbing Inspector from \$250.00 to \$500.00 per year. (line Item #22 a of Article #2 of the May 10, 1985 Annual Town Meeting).

Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money for the purchase of a new 1985 police cruiser, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Police Department).

It was voted to authorize the purchase of a new 1985 police cruiser for a total amount of \$11,669.00 and to pay for the cruiser by raising and appropriating the sum of \$4,874.00 and by transferring the balance of \$6,795.00 received in settlement for the damage to the 1984 police cruiser.

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer or borrow a sum of money to supplement the Brookfield Elementary School budget for Fiscal Year 1986, or take any action relative thereto. (Sponsored by the Brookfield School Committee).

It was voted to pass over Article 8.
